1. Content and Format of Report

This report has been prepared pursuant to Standing Order 89 (3), (4), (5) and (6) (Dáil Éireann) which provide that—

- Subject to Standing Order 107, each Select Committee shall review its
 procedures and its role generally, on an ongoing basis and shall report at
 least once in each year to the Committee on Procedure on these matters;
- Following its appointment and thereafter at annual intervals, each Select
 Committee shall prepare a work programme and shall lay such programme before Dáil Éireann.
- Each Select Committee shall, from time to time as the Select Committee sees fit, lay minutes of its proceedings before Dáil Éireann.
- Where
 - Dáil Éireann has appointed a date upon which a Select Committee shall report back to the Dáil and the interval between the appointment of such date and the date for reporting back exceeds one year, or
- ➤ No date for reporting back has been appointed by Dáil Éireann, Such Select Committee shall, on the anniversary of its appointment in each year following the year of such appointment, make an annual report to the Dáil Éireann which shall detail —
 - I. The work carried out by the Select Committee
 - II. The work in progress by the Select Committee

And may include, if the Select Committee deems appropriate, the report on its role (in which case, a copy of the annual report shall be forwarded to the Committee on Procedures) the work programme and minutes of proceedings referred to in paragraphs (3), (4) and (5) respectively of this Standing Order.

At its meeting on the 22 September 2020, the Select Committee agreed that all these items should be included in this report.

This report has been prepared pursuant to Standing Order 100 (3), (4), (5) and (6), (Dáil Éireann) and Standing Order 77 (3), (4), (5) and (6) (Seanad Éireann) which provide for the Select Committee to-

- undertake a review of its procedure and its role generally;
- prepare an annual work programme;
- lay minutes of its proceedings before both Houses;
- make an annual report to both Houses.

At its meeting on the 14 January 2021 the Select Committee agreed that all these items should be included in this report covering the period from 14 January 2021 to 15 December 2021.

2. Establishment and Functions

2.1. Establishment of the Select Committee

The Dáil Select Committee was established by Order of Dáil Éireann of the 28 July 2020, to consider Bills, Estimates for Public Services, Motions, and the terms of any international agreement involving a charge on public funds, which come within the aegis of the Department of Public Expenditure and Reform and Finance.

The Select Committee may also consider Annual Output Statements, Value for Money Reviews and Policy Reviews prepared by the relevant Government Department.

The Orders of Reference of the Dáil Select Committee are set out at Appendix 1.

3. Chair, Vice-Chair and Membership

Dáil Standing Order 104 (2) provides for a proportion of Chairs to be allocated to each group by means of the D'Hondt System. Deputy Neasa Hourigan was appointed as Chairman of the Select Committee on 9 September 2020 by an Order of Dáil Éireann. Deputy Mairéad Farrell was elected as Vice-Chairman of the Select Committee on the 22 September 2020.

Membership of the Committee, including all internal changes within the reported period, is listed at *Appendix 2*.

4. Meetings, Attendance and Recording

Meetings of the Select Committee took place in the Committee rooms in Leinster House 2000 or on Microsoft Teams. Meetings were in public unless otherwise ordered by the Committee.

Committee proceedings were broadcast live within Leinster House and also made available to RTE, TV3 and TG4. Proceedings were also live streamed on our website and through our app. Since September 2014 the proceedings of Committees in public session, typically recorded but occasionally live, are broadcast on the dedicated parliamentary channel Oireachtas TV which is available on these channels:

Appendix 1: Orders of Reference

Committee on Budgetary Oversight.

- 219. (1) There shall stand established as soon as may be, following the reassembly of the Dáil subsequent to a General Election, a Standing Committee, to be known as the Committee on Budgetary Oversight, to examine and, where it considers it appropriate, report to the Dáil on—
- (a) the overall fiscal position, including—
- (i) the aggregated position on revenue and expenditure and the General Government Balance, including structural targets;
- (ii) medium-term projections for the public finances;
- (iii) macro-economic forecasts and developments;
- (iv) general fiscal governance including the application of fiscal rules and risks to the fiscal position; and
- (v) matters arising from the introduction of a supplementary Estimate or Estimates that, in its opinion, have or may have significant budgetary implications: Provided that the Committee shall advise the appropriate Committee or Committees of any decision on its part to undertake such consideration and the reason or reasons therefor;
- (b) public expenditure policy, including— 109
- (i) the expenditure position having regard to the Government Expenditure Ceiling and the expenditure benchmark under the Stability and Growth Pact;
- (ii) Ministerial Expenditure Ceilings applying to individual Estimates or groups of Estimates for the Public Services where significant variations from the expenditure profile could potentially impact on the overall fiscal position; and
- (iii) the adequacy of planned and actual aggregate levels of capital expenditure and the policies and practices in relation to capital expenditure, including public procurement policy and public private partnership policy, intended to ensure the achievement of value for money.
- (c) Exchequer receipts policy.
- (2) The Committee may consider a matter of public policy with significant impact on the budgetary position or on the overall fiscal position: Provided that prior to the commencement of such consideration, the Cathaoirleach of the Committee

- shall consult with the relevant sectoral Committee established pursuant to Standing Order 95.
- (3) The Committee may also consider the overall framework for parliamentary engagement throughout the course of the budgetary cycle and may make recommendations thereon to the Committee on Standing Orders and Dáil Reform for that Committee's consideration under Standing Order 119(1)(b): Provided that, in so doing, the Committee shall consult with—
- (a) the Committees established pursuant to Standing Order 95 on any recommendations which, in the opinion of the Committee, impact on their role or remit; and
- (b) the relevant Minister or Ministers on any recommendations which, in the opinion of the Committee, impact on the role or remit of a Department or Departments,
- and shall notify the results of such consultations to Committee on Standing Orders and Dáil Reform.
- (4) The Committee shall have the following powers:
- (a) power to send for persons, papers and records as defined in Standing Orders 96(3) and 99;
- (b) power to take oral and written evidence and submissions as defined in Standing Order 96(1) and (2);
- (c) power to appoint sub-Committees as defined in Standing Order 96(4); (d) power to engage consultants as defined in Standing Order 96(14);
- (e) power to travel as defined in Standing Order 96(15).
- (5) Every report which the Committee proposes to make shall, on adoption by the Committee, be laid before the Dáil forthwith, whereupon the Committee shall be empowered to print and publish such report, together with such related documents it thinks fit. 110
- (6) The Committee shall consist of fifteen members, none of whom shall be a member of the Government or a Minister of State, and four of whom shall constitute a quorum: Provided that—
- (a) the Committee and any sub-Committees which it may appoint shall be constituted so as to be impartially representative of the Dáil; and
- (b) the provisions of Standing Order 106 shall apply to the Committee.
