Economic Regulation of Energy and Water



- Maintain security of supply
- Ensure efficient network delivery
- Promote competition and innovation
- Regulation of all-island wholesale electricity market
- Monitor performance of Irish Water

Protecting Energy and Water Customers



- Set quality of service standards
- Ensure customers treated fairly and at heart of transition to low carbon future
- Provide customers information about rights
- Offer dispute resolution service
- Promote customer protection and engagement (getting best value and service)

Energy Safety Regulation



- Protect public safety and prevent major accidents for:
 - Gas (networks, supply, storage, use and liquified petroleum gas distribution)
 - Petroleum exploration and production of hydrocarbons
- Ensure electrical contractors and gas installers operate to relevant national standards
- Promote customer awareness of safety
