Members of the Joint Committee were welcomed by the Abbey Theatre's Co-Directors, Caitríona McLaughlin and Mark O'Brien. Also in attendance were the Chair to the Abbey Theatre Board, Dr Frances Ruane, Board members Mairéad Delaney, Michael Owens, Owen Travers, and Michael Wall, alongside Gus McNamara (Director of Finance and Operations), Christine Monk (Director of Communications and Marketing), and Róisín McGann (Communications Manager).

Members received a tour of the current Abbey Theatre campus, a presentation on artistic and strategic plans for the Abbey Theatre and on its redevelopment plans, and the opportunity to peruse items from among the Abbey Theatre's archives.

TOUR OF ABBEY THEATRE CAMPUS

Members toured the Abbey Theatre campus, led by the Abbey Theatre Co-Directors. Members discussed audience participation and involvement, general limitations on number and quality of productions, matters relating to capital investment in the theatre campus, accessibility of the theatre campus, in addition to various health and safety topics.

REDEVELOPMENT

Members received a presentation on the Abbey Theatre's redevelopment plans.

Members discussed matters relating to timeframes and resources for the Abbey

Theatre redevelopment, cultural space infrastructure, technical audits, and the status
of co-productions and national theatres touring in Ireland.

CONCLUDING MATTERS

An emphatic point made during the course of the Committee's visit to the Abbey
Theatre was that the development of a new theatre as an establishment of cultural
and national significance should be a key priority within the coming years to facilitate
exchange and reflect the changing Irish identity.
