4. Briefly describe the trend you see in the number of female candidates from the 2011 Dáil general election up to the Dáil general election in 2020.
5. What are the major trends you see in the number of female TDs elected from the 2011 Dáil general election up to 2020?
6. Suggest one way that the number of female TDs could be increased.
