

Special Collections Attribution and Reuse policy.

Introduction

This document details the policy of the L&RS where items from its collections are requested to be used in academic or other publications, whether on or off line.

Public sector information reuse licence

The collections are shared under the PSI (Public Sector Information) reuse licence. This licence allows for copying, issuing copies to the public, publishing, broadcasting and translating into other languages. It also covers non-commercial use and study.

Policy

Where a request to copy or publish falls outside of the parameters of the PSI, explicit written permission must be sought where:

- The item is to be used in a research or academic paper or publication
- The item is to be used for the promotion of a cultural or historical event
- The item is to be used to illustrate or be included in a newspaper or journal article.

Explicit written permission must also be sought where it is proposed to manipulate or repurpose the image for creative, broadcasting or other use.

Attribution

The use of any item or image must have the 'Oireachtas Library & Research Service' credited as the source of the image.

The image will be referenced as follows:

"Item title and reference number (from L&RS Library Management System) curated by the Library & Research Service on behalf of the Houses of the Oireachtas Commission"

Due acknowledgement should be given where effort or input to identify and source the item was made by L&RS staff.
