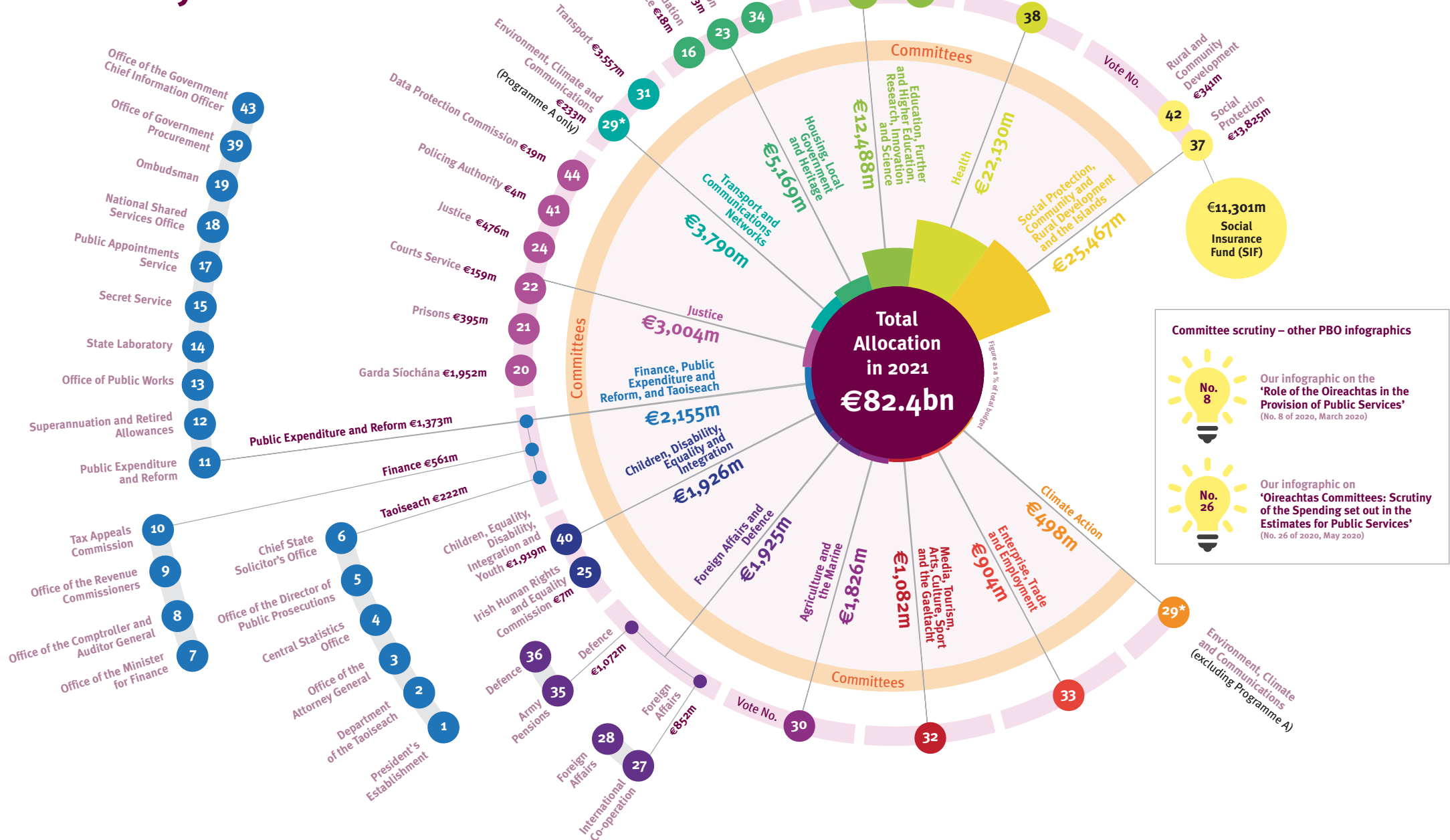


# Dáil Select Committees and the Ministerial Vote Groups which they scrutinise – 2021

Notes: The Committees of Dáil Éireann responsible for the scrutiny of Voted monies are shown above. The Committees are sorted counter-clockwise in accordance with the scale of the gross allocation of the Ministerial Vote Group(s) in respect of which they carry out scrutiny. Some Vote Groups are composed of several Votes while others have only one. The NTF and SIF are included with the Higher Education and the Social Protection Votes (respectively) as they are presented with these Votes in the Estimates. The NTF and SIF allocations of €741m and €11,301m (respectively) are included in the total allocations subject to scrutiny. For the first time, two different committees are responsible for the scrutiny of different programmes within the same Vote (29\*). The allocations shown do not include a sum of €748.5m in capital savings from 2020 which will be available for spending in 2021. Also not shown are the funds available to be allocated to Vote Groups in 2021 – the Covid Contingency Fund (€1,965m) and the Recovery Fund (€3,400m).
