**MESSAGES FROM THE GOVERNMENT**

**An Bille um an Dlí Coiriúil (Dlínse Sheach-Chríochach), 2018 [*Seanad*].**  
**Criminal Law (Extraterritorial Jurisdiction) Bill 2018 [*Seanad*].**

For the purpose of Article 17.2 of the Constitution, the Government recommend that it is expedient to authorise such payments out of moneys provided by the Oireachtas as are necessary to give effect to any Act of the present session to extend the criminal law of the State

to certain conduct engaged in outside the State and in that regard to give effect to certain provisions of the Council of Europe Convention on preventing and combating violence against women and domestic violence done at Istanbul on 11 May 2011; for that purpose to amend the Criminal Justice (Mutual Assistance) Act 2008; and to provide for related matters.
