b6. “Go ndéanann Dáil Eireann:

dlúthpháirtíocht na hÉireann le muintir na Bealarúise maidir lena gcosaint shíochánta ar phrionsabail dhaonlathacha agus ar chearta bunúsacha an duine a dhearbhú;

a dhiúltíú do dhlisteanacht dhaonlathach Alexander Lukashenko tar éis toghchán uachtaráin calaoiseach an 9 Lúnasa 2020 nach raibh cóir ná cothrom;

an foréigean agus an cos ar bolg a rinneadh ag réimeas Lukashenko sa tréimhse thíreach roimh an toghchán sin agus dá éis sin a cháineadh, lena n-áirítear a ghníomhartha chun an freasúra, sochaí shibhialta agus na meáin neamhspleácha a chur ina dtost trí ollghabhálacha, pionóis choiriúla throma,

That Dáil Eireann:

affirms Ireland’s solidarity with the Belarusian people in their peaceful defence of democratic principles and fundamental human rights;

rejects the democratic legitimacy of Alexander Lukashenko following the fraudulent 9th August, 2020, presidential election that was neither free nor fair;

condemns the violence and repression perpetrated by the Lukashenko regime in the run up to, and in the aftermath of, that election, including its actions to silence the opposition, civil society and independent media through mass arrests, heavy criminal penalties, internet shutdowns and restrictions

múchadh an idirlín agus srianta ar shaoirsí na meán;

tuirlingt éigeantach chomhéigineach a rinneadh le déanaí ag údaráis na Bealarúise ar aerárthach Ryanair, a bhí ag eitilt idir príomhchathracha Aontais Eorpaigh (AE), lenar cuireadh saol na bpaisinéirí agus na foirne i mbaol agus lenar léiríodh neamháird mínaireach ar an dlí idirnáisiúnta, a cháineadh tuilleadh;

a iarraidh go scaoilfear saor Roman Protasevich, Sofia Sapega agus gach duine a gabhadh go héagórách sa Bhealarúis láithreach agus gan choinníollacha;

a thabhairt dá haire:

- nádúr fiorspontáineach agus fiorshíochánta na gluaiseachta agóide sa Bhealarúis tar éis thoghchán uachtaráin neamhdhlisteanach Lúnasa 2020;
- an easpa gníomhaíochta ag údaráis na Bealarúise chun imscrúdú a dhéanamh go leordhóthanach ar líomhaintí maidir le sáruithe ar chearta an duine, amhail éigniú, leictreaghortú agus cineálacha eile céasta;
- imní láidir Rapóirtéir Speisialta na Náisiún Aontaithe i dtaoibh staid chosantóirí chearta an duine maidir le géarleanúint ar bhanchosantóirí chearta an duine agus coiriúlú dáiríre obair chearta an duine;
- tiomantas na hÉireann don staid sa Bhealarúis a choimeád go hard ar an gclár oibre idirnáisiúnta, lena n-áirítear ag Comhairle na Náisiún Aontaithe um Chearta an Duine agus ag cruinnithe de chomhaltaí de Chomhairle Slándála na Náisiún Aontaithe; agus

on media freedoms;

further condemns the recent coercive forced landing by the Belarusian authorities of a Ryanair aircraft, that was flying between European Union (EU) capitals, which endangered the lives of the passengers and crew and showed a flagrant disregard for international law;

calls for the immediate and unconditional release of Roman Protasevich, Sofia Sapega and all those unjustly detained in Belarus;

welcomes the initiation of an investigation by the International Civil Aviation Organization and calls on the Belarusian authorities to fully cooperate with that investigation;

further welcomes the firm response of the European Council during their meeting on 24th May, and affirms Ireland's continued support for coordinated EU measures;

notes:

- the genuinely spontaneous and peaceful nature of the protest movement in Belarus following the illegitimate August 2020 presidential election;
- the lack of action by the Belarusian authorities to adequately investigate allegations of human rights violations, such as rape, electrocution and other forms of torture;
- the strong concerns of the United Nations Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights defenders regarding the persecution of women human rights defenders and the effective criminalisation of human rights work;
- Ireland's commitment to keeping the situation in Belarus high on the international agenda, including at the United Nations Human Rights Council and at meetings of United Nations Security Council members; and
- Ireland's vocal and steadfast support for the Belarusian people and Belarusian civil society, including through support for projects that seek to protect human

rights and media freedoms; and

urges the Belarusian authorities to:

- implement the recommendations of the November 2020 report of Professor Wolfgang Benedek arising from the Organization for Security and Co-operation in Europe's Moscow Mechanism;
- engage with the United Nations Special Rapporteur on the situation of human rights in Belarus and grant her access to the country in her official capacity;
- fully engage with the Office of the United Nations High Commissioner for Human Rights in her investigation into the over two thousand reports of human rights violations, including torture, ill-treatment and physical and sexual abuse of detainees;
- end the impunity with which Belarusian security forces are permitted to act and to permit independent and transparent investigations into the deaths in custody of Raman Bandarenka and Witold Ashurok; and
- engage in a meaningful and inclusive national dialogue with the political opposition and civil society, with a view to making needed reforms in advance of fresh elections that are free, fair and independently monitored.”
