the position of these entities in declining invitations from the Joint Committee to attend hearings of the Joint Committee and to be accountable to Parliament;

- acknowledges the support of the Governor of the Central Bank of Ireland in calling for the unregulated private investment funds and regulated credit service firms to attend at the Joint Committee on the basis that ‘firms with a serious role in the Irish economy have a social responsibility to account for themselves before the Committee’;
- notes the information provided by the Department of Finance detailing the level of engagement with the funds industry from 2013 to 2016 detailing approximately 125 relevant meetings held, thus demonstrating the level of interaction between the funds industry and the Department over those years;
- calls on the Government to implement the recommendations contained in paragraphs 17 and 18 of the Report, namely:
 - to cease all engagement with unregulated private investment funds and regulated credit service firms until these entities are accountable to Parliament; and
