- condemns unequivocally the unlawful act by the Belarusian authorities of the interception of a Ryanair flight between Greece and Lithuania on Sunday 23rd May, 2021;
 - acknowledges the set of sanctions proposed by the Council of the European Union (EU) in response to this unlawful act;
