ARRANGEMENTS FOR BUSINESS FOR
TUESDAY TO THURSDAY, 9 - 11 APRIL 2019
(AS AGREED ON 5 APRIL 2019)

Announcement of Business for the Week:

Tuesday's business shall be:

- Item 13, Motion re Electoral (Supplement to the Register of Electors) Regulations 2019;
- Item 14, Motion to instruct the Committee on the Residential Tenancies (Amendment) (No. 2) Bill 2018;
- Item 35, Pre-European Council Statements; and
- Item 15, Motion re Article 4 of the 19th and 21st Protocols Annexed to the Lisbon Treaty (Referral to Joint Committee).

Private Members' Business shall be Item 57, Thirty-Eighth Amendment of the Constitution (Neutrality) Bill 2018 Second Stage, selected by Sinn Féin.

Wednesday's business shall be:

- Item 16, Motion re Direct Election of Mayor Plebiscite Regulations;
- Item 9, Regulated Professions (Health and Social Care) (Amendment) Bill 2019 Order for Second Stage and Second Stage;
- Item 8, Courts (Establishment and Constitution) (Amendment) Bill 2019 Order for Second Stage and Second Stage;
- Item 36, Statements on Rural and Community Development; and
- Item 1, Land and Conveyancing Law Reform (Amendment) Bill 2019 [Seanad] Second Stage.

Private Members' Business shall be Item 220, Motion re Housing, selected by the Labour party.

Thursday's business shall be:

- Items 17 and 18, Motions re Article 4 of the 19th and 21st Protocols Annexed to the Lisbon Treaty (back from Joint Committee);
- Item 19, Motion re Revised Estimates (back from Committee);
- Item 37, Statements on A Better World – Ireland's Policy for International Development; and

- Item 58, Treatment of Cancer (Advertisements) Bill 2018 (Deputy Kate O’Connell) Second Stage.

Second Stage of Item 59, Finance (Office of Tax Simplification) Bill 2018 (Deputy Michael McGrath) shall be debated in the evening slot.

Announcement of Proposed Arrangements for this week’s business:

In relation to Tuesday’s business, it is proposed that:

1. Item 13, Motion re Electoral (Supplement to the Register of Electors) Regulations 2019 and Item 14, Motion to instruct the Committee on the Residential Tenancies (Amendment) (No. 2) Bill 2018 shall be taken without debate and any division demanded thereon shall be taken immediately.
2. Item 35, Pre-European Council Statements shall be taken on the conclusion of Questions for Oral Answer to the Taoiseach. The Statements shall be brought to a conclusion after 85 minutes if not previously concluded. Statements shall be confined to a single round for a Minister or Minister of State and the main spokespersons for parties and groups, or a member nominated in their stead, shall not exceed 10 minutes each with a 5 minute response by a Minister or Minister of State. All members may share time. Parliamentary Questions for Oral Answer to the Minister for Housing, Planning and Local Government shall be taken on the conclusion of the Statements.
3. Item 15, Motion re Article 4 of the 19th and 21st Protocols Annexed to the Lisbon Treaty (Referral to Joint Committee) shall conclude within 45 minutes. Speeches shall be confined to a single round for a Minister or Minister of State and the main spokespersons for parties and groups, or a member nominated in their stead for a period not exceeding 5 minutes each, with a 5 minute response by a Minister or Minister of State and all members may share time. Any division demanded thereon shall be taken immediately.
4. Item 57, Second Stage of the Thirty-Eighth Amendment of the Constitution (Neutrality) Bill 2018 shall be taken on the conclusion of Motion re Article 4 of the 19th and 21st Protocols Annexed to the Lisbon Treaty (Referral to Joint Committee). The Dáil shall sit later than 10 p.m. and shall adjourn on the conclusion of Second Stage of Item 57, which shall conclude within two hours.

In relation to Wednesday’s business, it is proposed that:

1. Item 16, Motion re Direct Election of Mayor Plebiscite Regulations, shall conclude within 45 minutes and Speeches shall be confined to a single round for a Minister or Minister of State and the main spokespersons for parties and groups, or a member nominated in their

stead of 5 minutes, with a 5 minute response by a Minister or Minister of State and all members may share time.

2. Item 36, Statements on Rural and Community Development, the Statement of a Minister or Minister of State and the main spokespersons for parties and groups, or a member nominated in their stead, shall not exceed 10 minutes each, with 10 minutes for all other members, a 5 minute response by a Minister or Minister of State and all members may share time.

In relation to Thursday's business, it is proposed that:

1. Items 17 and 18, Motion re Article 4 of the 19th Protocol Annexed to the Lisbon Treaty (Back from Joint Committee) and Motion re Article 4 of the 21st Protocol Annexed to the Lisbon Treaty (Back from Joint Committee) shall be taken without debate.
2. Item 19, Motion re Revised Estimates (back from Committee) shall take place following Items 17 and 18 and be followed immediately by the Weekly Divisions and shall conclude within 45 minutes. The Estimates shall be moved together and decided by one Question. Speeches shall be confined to a single round for a Minister or Minister of State and the main spokespersons for parties and groups, or a member nominated in their stead for a period not exceeding 5 minutes each, with a 5 minute response by a Minister or Minister of State and all members may share time and any division demanded thereon shall be taken immediately.
3. Item 37, Statements on A Better World – Ireland's Policy for International Development shall adjourn after 90 minutes, if not previously concluded. Statements of a Minister or Minister of State and the main spokespersons for parties and groups, or a member nominated in their stead shall not exceed 10 minutes each, with 5 minutes for all other members, a 5 minute response by a Minister or Minister of State and all members may share time.
4. That the Order of the Dáil of 12 December 2018, that Second Stage of Item 58, Treatment of Cancer (Advertisements) Bill 2018, be taken in Private Members' time, be discharged and that Second Stage be taken in Government time.
