**Announcement of Proposed Arrangements for this week's business:**

In relation to Tuesday's business there are 4 proposals. It is proposed that:

1. on foot of the Order of the Dáil at 2 p.m. in Leinster House and the consequential suspension of sitting, the normal timings of items of business under the weekly schedule agreed on 22nd October, 2020 shall be moved on by 90 minutes;
2. the Dáil shall sit later than 11.17 p.m., and shall adjourn on the conclusion of Questions to the Minister for Environment, Climate and Communications;
3. Item 7, Motion re Ministerial Rota for Parliamentary Questions, Item 8, Motion re Referral to Joint Committee of proposed approval by Dáil Éireann of Technological Universities Act 2018 (Section 36)(Appointed Day) Order 2020, and Item 9, Motion re Appointment of Members of the Legal Services Regulatory Authority, shall be taken without debate and any division demanded on the Motion re Ministerial Rota for Parliamentary Questions shall be taken immediately; and

Item 9a, Motion re Confidence in Tánaiste and Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment, shall be brought to a conclusion within 110 minutes, with arrangements in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30th July, 2020, for 100 minutes, followed by a 10-minute statement in reply by a Minister or Minister of State, and all members may share time.
