4. **Item 14a**, Motion re Leave to Introduce Supplementary Estimates 2020 [Votes 9 and 38], shall be taken without debate;
5. **Item 14b**, Motion re Referral to Select Committee of Supplementary Estimates 2020 [Votes 9 and 38], shall, subject to agreement of leave to introduce, be taken without debate;
6. **Item 14c**, Withdrawal of the United Kingdom from the European Union (Consequential Provisions) Bill 2020 – Financial Resolutions, shall be moved together and decided without debate by one Question;
7. **Item 20**, Statements on Community Safety and Preventing Crime, shall not exceed 210 minutes, with arrangements in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30th July, 2020, for 200 minutes, followed by a 10-minute statement in reply by a Minister or Minister of State, and all members may share time; and
8. **Item 21**, Criminal Justice (Mutual Recognition of Decisions on Supervision Measures) Bill 2019 [*Seanad*] – Report and Final Stages, shall be taken not earlier than 9 p.m.

 4. **Item 23**, Statements by the Minister at the Department of Further and Higher Education, Research, Innovation and Science on an update of the Work of the new Department, shall not exceed 110 minutes, with arrangements in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30th July, 2020, for 100 minutes, followed by a 10-minute statement in reply by a Minister or Minister of State, and all members may share time; and
 5. **Item 15**, Motion re Final Report of the Special Committee on Covid-19 Response, shall not exceed **2 hours and 35 minutes**, commencing with a speech by the former Chair of the Committee which shall not exceed 10 minutes, and otherwise with arrangements in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30th July, 2020, for 135 minutes, followed by a 5-minute speech in reply by a Minister or Minister of State, **and a concluding 5-minute speech by the former Chair of the Committee**, and all members may share time.
