## Announcement of Business for the Week:

Tuesday's business shall be:

- **Item 8**, Motion *re* Proposed approval by Dáil Éireann of the Protection of Young Persons (Employment) (Exclusion of Workers in the Fishing and Shipping Sectors) Regulations 2021 (*without debate*)
- **Item 9**, Motion *re* Report of the Committee on Standing Orders and Dáil Reform (*without debate*)

**Announcement of Proposed Arrangements for this week's business:**

In relation to Tuesday's business, it is proposed that:

1. the Dáil shall sit later than 10.30 p.m. and shall adjourn on the conclusion of topical issues;
2. **Item 8**, Motion re Proposed approval by Dáil Éireann of the Protection of Young Persons (Employment) (Exclusion of Workers in the Fishing and Shipping Sectors) Regulations 2021, and **Item 9**, Report of the Committee on Standing Orders and Dáil Reform, shall be taken without debate;
3. **Item 23**, Statements to mark Europe Day, shall not exceed 145 minutes, with arrangements in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30 July 2020 for 135 minutes, followed by a statement in response by a Minister or Minister of State not exceeding 10 minutes, and all members may share time;
4. **Item 161**, Motion re Institutional Investors in the Residential Property Market, shall be taken immediately following the Statements to mark Europe Day and the proceedings thereon shall be brought to a conclusion after two hours; and
5. Oral parliamentary questions pursuant to Standing Order 46(1)(b) to the Minister for Foreign Affairs shall be taken for 90 minutes immediately following Item 161.

In relation to Wednesday's business, it is proposed that:

1. the Dáil shall sit later than 9.30 p.m. and shall adjourn on the conclusion of the weekly division time which shall be taken on the conclusion of proceedings on the Planning and Development, Heritage and Broadcasting (Amendment) Bill 2021;
2. Second Stage of **Item 36**, Companies (Protection of Employees' Rights in Liquidations) Bill 2021, shall be taken on the conclusion of topical issues and the proceedings thereon shall be brought to a conclusion after 2 hours;

3. the proceedings on Second Stage of **Item 24**, the Private Security Services (Amendment) Bill 2021, shall be brought to a conclusion following a speech in response by a Minister or Minister of State, which shall be taken following the first round of speakers in accordance with those arrangements agreed by Order of the Dáil on 30 July 2020, and any division demanded on the proceedings on the second reading motion shall be taken immediately prior to Committee Stage;
4. in relation to **Item 5**, the Loan Guarantee Schemes Agreements (Strategic Banking Corporation of Ireland) Bill 2021—
  - (i) the proceedings on Second Stage shall be brought to a conclusion after 115 minutes, with arrangements for speaking in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30 July 2020, save that the times shall be halved in each instance, and a Minister or Minister of State may make a 10-minute speech in response;
  - (ii) any division demanded on the proceedings on the second reading motion shall be taken immediately; and
  - (iii) Committee and remaining Stages shall be brought to a conclusion after 60 minutes by one question which shall be put from the Chair and which shall, in relation to amendments, include only those set down or accepted by the Tánaiste and Minister for Enterprise, Trade and Employment;
5. **Item 9a**, Financial Resolution on the Private Security Services (Amendment) Bill 2021 shall be taken on the conclusion of proceedings on item 5, without debate, and any division demanded thereon shall be taken immediately;
6. the proceedings on Committee and remaining Stages of **Item 24**, Private Security Services (Amendment) Bill 2021, shall be brought to a conclusion after 30 minutes by one question which shall be put from the Chair and which shall, in relation to amendments, include only those set down or accepted by the Minister for Justice; and
7. in relation to the Planning and Development, Heritage and Broadcasting (Amendment) Bill 2021—
  - (i) the Order of Referral to the Select Committee on Housing, Local Government and Heritage shall stand discharged, and Committee Stage shall be taken in Committee of the whole Dáil, and

- (ii) Committee and remaining Stages shall be brought to a conclusion after 30 minutes by one question which shall be put from the Chair and which shall, in relation to amendments, include only those set down or accepted by the Minister for Housing, Local Government and Heritage.

In relation to Thursday's business, it is proposed that:
