Announcement of Proposed Arrangements for this week's business:

In relation to Tuesday's business, it is proposed that:

1. the Dáil shall sit later than 10.30 p.m. and shall adjourn on the conclusion of topical issues pursuant to Standing Order 37, which shall be taken on the conclusion of oral Parliamentary Questions to the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform pursuant to Standing Order 46(1);
2. **Item 9**, Motion *re* Proposed approval by Dáil Éireann of the Sectoral Employment Order (Construction Sector) 2021, shall be taken without debate;
3. **Item 10**, Motion *re* Ministerial Rota for Parliamentary Questions, shall be taken without debate;
4. **Item 11**, Motion *re* Proposed authorisation by Dáil Éireann for the Houses of the Oireachtas Commission to instruct legal counsel, shall be taken without debate;
5. **Item 12**, Motion *re* Extension of relevant period within the meaning of sections 1 to 7 and 9 of the Civil Law (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act 2021, shall, if not previously concluded, be brought to a conclusion after 55 minutes, and the following arrangements shall apply:

 - (iv) a Minister or Minister of State may make a speech in reply which shall not exceed 5 minutes;
6. **Item 200**, Motion *re* the National Ambulance Service, shall take place on the conclusion of Second Stage of the Sex Offenders (Amendment) Bill 2021, or at 6.40 p.m., whichever is the earlier, and shall, if not previously concluded, be brought to a conclusion after two hours; and

7. Oral Parliamentary Questions to the Minister for Public Expenditure and Reform pursuant to Standing Order 46(1) shall be taken on the conclusion of Private Members' Business and shall conclude within 90 minutes.

4. in relation to **Item 43**, Statements on the Air Accident Investigation Unit Final Report into R116 air accident, the following arrangements shall apply:
 - (i) the statements shall be taken on the conclusion of Second Stage of the Sex Offenders (Amendment) Bill 2021, or at 6.35 p.m., whichever is the earlier, and shall not exceed 145 minutes, with arrangements in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30th July, 2020, for 135 minutes, following which a Minister or Minister of State may make a statement in reply which shall not exceed 10 minutes;
 - (ii) members may share time; and
 - (iii) in the event that the statements conclude before 9 p.m., the sitting shall be suspended until 9 p.m.; and
5. the Order of Referral to the Select Committee on Children, Equality, Disability, Integration and Youth of **Item 43a**, the Child and Family Agency (Amendment) Bill 2021, hereby stands discharged and Committee, Report and Final Stages shall take place today, with Committee Stage to be taken in Committee of the whole Dáil, either on the conclusion of the Statements on the Air Accident Investigation Unit Final Report into R116 air accident, or at 9 p.m., whichever is the later.
