**TUESDAY TO THURSDAY, 23 - 25 NOVEMBER 2021**  
**(AS AGREED ON 18 November 2021)**

**Announcement of Business for the Week:**

Tuesday's business shall be:

- **Item 37**, Statements on the Climate Action Plan 2021 (*to conclude within 145 minutes*)

Private Members' Business shall be **Item 199**, Motion *re* Mother and Baby Homes Redress Scheme, selected by Sinn Féin.

Wednesday's business shall be:

- **Item 7**, Motion *re* Leave to Introduce Supplementary Estimates [Votes 6, 29, 33 and 37] (*without debate*)
- **Item 8**, Motion *re* Referral of Supplementary Estimates [Votes 6, 29, 33 and 37] to Select Committee (*subject to agreement of motion re leave to introduce*) (*without debate*)
- **Item 3**, Merchant Shipping (Investigation of Marine Casualties) (Amendment) Bill 2021 (Second Stage) (*to be adjourned at 5 p.m., if not previously concluded*)
- **Item 38**, Statements on Covid-19 and the New Measures (*to be taken at 5 p.m. or on conclusion of Second Stage of the Merchant Shipping (Investigation of Marine Casualties) (Amendment) Bill 2021, whichever is the earlier, and to conclude within 210 minutes*)
- **Item 38a**, Land and Conveyancing Law Reform Bill 2021 [*Seanad*] (Committee and remaining Stages) (*to be taken no earlier than 8.30 p.m.*)

**Announcement of Proposed Arrangements for this week's business:**

In relation to Tuesday's business, it is proposed that:

1. the Dáil shall sit later than 10.30 p.m. and shall adjourn on the conclusion of topical issues pursuant to Standing Order 37, which shall be taken on the conclusion of oral Parliamentary Questions to the Minister for Education pursuant to Standing Order 46(1);
2. **Item 37**, Statements on the Climate Action Plan 2021, shall not exceed 145 minutes, with arrangements in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30th July, 2020, for 135 minutes, following which a Minister or Minister of State may make a statement in reply which shall not exceed 10 minutes, and members may share time;
3. **Item 199**, Motion *re* Mother and Baby Homes Redress Scheme, shall take place on the conclusion of the Statements on the Climate Action Plan 2021 and shall, if not previously concluded, be brought to a conclusion after two hours; and
4. Oral Parliamentary Questions to the Minister for Education pursuant to Standing Order 46(1) shall be taken on the conclusion of Private Members' Business and shall conclude within 90 minutes.

In relation to Wednesday's business, it is proposed that:

1. the Dáil shall sit later than 9.30 p.m. and shall adjourn on the conclusion of the weekly division time, which shall take place on the conclusion of Second Stage of **Item 38b**, the Criminal Justice (Smuggling of Persons) Bill 2021 [*Seanad*]; in the event there are no deferred divisions, the Dáil shall adjourn on the conclusion of Second Stage of the Criminal Justice (Smuggling of Persons) Bill 2021 [*Seanad*];
2. Second Stage of **Item 48**, Education (Health, Relationships and Sex Education) Bill 2021, shall, if not previously concluded, be brought to a conclusion after two hours;
3. **Item 7**, Motion *re* Leave to Introduce Supplementary Estimates [Votes 6, 29, 33 and 37] and, subject to the agreement of the motion for leave to introduce, **Item 8**, Motion *re* Referral of Supplementary Estimates [Votes 6, 29, 33 and 37] to Select Committee, shall be taken without debate;
4. Second Stage of **Item 3**, Merchant Shipping (Investigation of Marine Casualties) (Amendment) Bill 2021, shall, if not previously concluded, be adjourned at 5 p.m., and if adjourned, shall not be resumed today;

5. the following arrangements shall apply in relation to **Item 38**, Statements on Covid-19 and the New Measures:
  - (i) the statements shall be taken on the conclusion of Second Stage of the Merchant Shipping (Investigation of Marine Casualties) (Amendment) Bill 2021, or at 5.00 p.m., whichever is the earlier, and shall not exceed 210 minutes, with arrangements in accordance with those agreed by Order of the Dáil of 30th July, 2020, for 200 minutes, following which a Minister or Minister of State may make a statement in reply which shall not exceed 10 minutes;
  - (ii) members may share time; and
  - (iii) in the event that the statements conclude before 8.30 p.m., the sitting shall be suspended until 8.30 p.m.;
6. the Order of Referral to the Select Committee on Justice of **Item 38a**, the Land and Conveyancing Law Reform Bill 2021 [*Seanad*], hereby stands discharged, and Committee, Report and Final Stages of the Bill shall take place today, with Committee Stage to be taken in Committee of the whole Dáil, either on the conclusion of the Statements on Covid-19 and the New Measures, or at 8.30 p.m., whichever is the later; and
7. the Order of Referral to the Select Committee on Justice of **Item 38b**, Criminal Justice (Smuggling of Persons) Bill 2021 [*Seanad*], hereby stands discharged, and Committee, Report and Final Stages of the Bill shall take place today, with Committee Stage to be taken in Committee of the whole Dáil, on the conclusion of the Land and Conveyancing Law Reform Bill 2021 [*Seanad*].
